## NEWSLETTER FOR END OF THIRD TERM 2021/2022 ACADEMIC SESSION

### HIGHLIGHTS OF THIRD TERM ACTIVITIES

a) **Academic:**

The College resumed on the 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 for the third term. Dedication of the College to God in solemn assembly was on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May, 2022.

#### **WASSCE, BECE, NABTEB and NECO Exams:**

WASSCE (SS3) started on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May and ended on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2022.

BECE (JSS3) Started Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May and ended Monday 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 while their placement exam that was conducted by NABTEB took place on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2022.

NABTEB (SS3) started Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June and ended 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 while NECO is on-going.

We wish they will pass in flying colours in the exam, in Jesus Christ name, Amen.

b) **Mid-term Break:**

The mid-term break took place on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.

c) **Projects:**

- 500 capacity Boys' Hostel complex is presently at the 1<sup>st</sup> lintel level.
- Whole Renovation of the Admin block is rapidly on-going
- The Landscaping and beautification of the front of the College and environs will commence in August, among others.

d) **Discipline:**

The College disciplinary tone is quite high but pockets of bullying and extortion still exist. Erring students are not spared. Recently, an SS3 student was suspended indefinitely on account of assault to a teaching staff.

Please, encourage your child/ward to be of good behaviour in the midst of other students. Also they should report any case of bullying, not minding the threat from the senior students, for immediate attention of the College authority.

e) **P.T.A General Meeting/Election:**

This was held on the 25<sup>th</sup> of May, 2022 and old PTA Exco Committee dissolved. General election that was conducted on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June, 2022 ushered in the New PTA Exco. Try to comply with your PTA obligations to enable the new Exco serve you better.

### **UP-COMING EVENTS/ACTIVITIES**

i) **SIWES:**

All students in ST2 (Technical) are to undergo Students Industrial Works Experience Scheme (SIWES) during this holiday. The forms were given to them. The training is compulsory and teachers are to supervise them wherever they choose to serve.

All ST2 Technical students are to come with the following technical drawing instruments which will be checked at the gate:

- Drawing Board (Famaca)
- Tee Square (Iron type)
- Engineering drawing instruments (rotering)
- Set square



- French curves
- Pencils (3H, HB, H or 2B)
- Eraser (tikky)
- Sharpener
- Drawing book or drawing sheet – 20 Nos.
- Pater Tape
- Scale rule

ii) **Taking Personal Property Home:**

Students should take all their personal belongings home so as to present them on checking-in. Nothing should be kept in staff guardian's house. These include mattress, uniform, Cortina, bucket, plates, cutlery set, water can, etc. They will be checked at the College gate. SS3 students writing NECO (SSCE) will destroy them as they remain behind!

**NOTE:** All SS/ST3 students must show their mattress at the gate; before they are checked in.

iii) **Locker and Chair:**

Many students have destroyed both their lockers and chairs. Each child is to provide his/her locker and chair on return next term. Otherwise, they will not be checked in, on resumption.

iv) **2021/2022 Session Yearbook for all students:**

This was decided during the last P.T.A General meeting. The cost is two thousand naira five hundred naira (N2,500.00) only. All students to pay cash on collection of the book at the College gate on resumption for first term 2022/2023 Session.

v) **School Uniform:**

It is against the school rule to put on pencil trousers, oversized shirts, tight-fitting skirts and other things that are not the proper uniform. Parents should sew new dresses or buy from the College as they resume to replace their already turned brown white shirts. At the College gate, students will be made to show the following:

- A pair of day-wear
- A pair of Sunday wear
- Complete sets of school uniform with badges
- A pair of Cortina (black) shoe – customized sample sold in school.
- A pair of black sandals – for use after school.

- A pair of simple white canvas shoes etc (compulsory for sports/games) – not booth.

vi) **Boarding House Requirements:**

All boarding students are to submit the following items on resumption at the College gate:

- f. All Junior and senior students – JSS1 – 3 and SS/ST1 – SS/ST3 are to submit one dip plate (bowl) and flat plate. This is to facilitate proper serving of their meals. Encourage your child not to take plates to the hostels.
- g. All students are to present their cutlery sets at the gate for checking-in.
- h. Cortina shoes is compulsory for checking-in, student without Cortina or any of the stipulated items will not be checked-in. Prepare to buy from the College if you don't have.
- i. One (1) energy saving blub (torch or TK brand) – medium size

vii) **Fees Payment:**

All fees are **Compulsory** and should be paid using the bill and code provided by the Central Billing System (CBS). Any student owing arrears of

fees must complete the payment with evidence before being allowed into the College premises.

**NOTE: Please, stop paying money into the accounts of members of staff. Such action is at the owner's risk.**

**Steps on how to make payment through the Central Billing System:**

- Visit [centralbillingfuc.com](http://centralbillingfuc.com)., select preferred school (FSTC Ohanso).
- Log on to the payment portal with your unique details (username and password).
- Click on "payment/bills", click on "current bill" to retrieve RRR code.
- Log on to the portal with your username and password, click on "**payment history**" to print receipt.
- Should you have any further enquiries, kindly chat live with a customer agent via [centralbillingfuc.com](http://centralbillingfuc.com) or call **09087995921**.
- Please, note that the Central Billing System is the only recognized portal for payment, and as such any RRR code generated from a different platform (Remita) using any other fee description (e.g. BEFUND, TENDER, etc) will not be regarded by the school.

**Debtors will not be allowed into the College.** Avoid paying school fees into PTA account and vice-versa.


